## Current Rail Freight Situation – Ukraine and Russia

The current geopolitical conflict between Ukraine and Russia is having a far-reaching impact on the global supply chain that will continue in the coming days.

Rail traffic along the Eurasian corridor is currently operational. CEVA Silk Road operations and services do not cross through the conflict zone in Ukraine, so all trains are operating under normal conditions.

Our Silk Road services remain open (east- and west-bound): through China, Kazakhstan, Russia, Belarus and European countries.

The following border crossings remain open (east- and west-bound): Alashankou, Khorgos, Manzhouli, Eerlian, Brest/Mala, Svisloch/Siemianowka, Bruzgi/Kuznica, Kaliningrad.

We continue to dialog with our rail service providers in China and Europe, including sea-rail operators, to ensure continuity, monitoring and security for Silk Road shipments. We do not anticipate major disruptions, but we are developing contingency options as we monitor the ever-evolving situation.



- **Red Line:** main lane Duisburg – Xi'an – Duisburg via Malaszewicze border station
- **Blue Line:** alternative lane Duisburg – Xi'an – Duisburg via Siemianowka border station
- **Yellow Line:** main lane Duisburg – Xi'an – Duisburg via Kaliningrad port
