Road freight shipments arriving from outside the UK:

Shipments arriving from outside the UK must either transit under customs control to an inland customs warehouse or customs clear at the first UK border crossing (port of entry)

Deliveries should arrive at the venue on the day that they are required on the stand. Deliveries will be unloaded direct to the stand unless instructed otherwise. The same instruction will apply for collecting vehicles after the event. Deliveries should arrive at the onsite warehouse a minimum of 48 hours prior to required delivery to stand.

It is very important that you contact us in advance of shipping so that we can advise and check on customs paperwork before goods depart from origin.




ITAR



All cargo containing wood entering into the EU (except coming from Switzerland) must be fumigated in its country of origin prior to shipment. This regulation includes but is not limited to such items as crates, pallets, frames, drums etc. To guarantee that the fumigation has been applied, the following information MUST be marked or stamped onto the outside of each package.

- Licence number assigned to the fumigation company
- Fumigation method (Heat Treated or Methyl Bromide used)

Strategic goods entering the United
Kingdom are subject to applicable UK
legislation. Specifically, it is the UK Export
Control Order 2008 which sets forth the
controls and licensing requirements
established for strategic goods placed on the
UK Strategic Export Control Lists. It is the
exhibitor's responsibility to actively determine
whether any of their items appear on the
consolidated list of strategic military and dualuse items that require export authorization.

Breakdown particularly will see lots of vehicles around the halls from 16.30 – 20.00.

To allow shell scheme exhibitors to leave site quickly CEVA are offering a collection from stand and warehouse service on the Wednesday evening to allow exhibitors a swift getaway at the end of show.

At 16.30 CEVA will deliver a empty pallet to all exhibitors who have prebooked this service. Simply place all items onto the pallet and notify our service desk in Hall 20 once the goods are ready for collection.

Your pallet will then be taken to our onsite warehouse at The NEC for collection by your transport company between 08.00-16.30 Thursday 27th and Friday 28th. Goods not collected by close of business Friday 28th will incur additional storage charges.

The cost for this service is £80.00 +VAT per standard pallet maximum height 1.8m.

All order must be prebooked by Tuesday 25th April.
