Ready to export to the EU?

Exporters from GB to the EU: don't forget anything!

Check now the conditions to respect to guarantee the compliance of your shipments: time saving, efficiency and peace of mind guaranteed!

Send by e-mail the commercial invoice and the packing list with the following details:

- Incoterm
- HS Codes for all your goods
- Tariff codes and origin of the goods (please provide certificate of origin if needed)
- Exporter GB EORI number
- Importer EORI number in the EU

Send certificates of origins (if any) with the goods (original document is mandatory) or make sure to provide the right statement on origin in accordance with Trade & Cooperation Agreement

Who is in charge of the export customs clearance?

- If you want CEVA to perform your export customs declaration, please make sure you have signed the direct representative form
- If you are making your own export customs declaration, please send it to CEVA

Import details

- Please provide CEVA with your importer's contact details (name, phone, e-mail, address)
- Please advise which customs office is chosen by your EU importer to perform import customs on the Continent
- Optional information:** does your importer want CEVA to perform your EU import declarations? If yes, the CEVA customs team will get in touch with the importer to organize import customs.

Guidelines for GB exporters

<input type="checkbox"/> Do you have a GB EORI Number?	<p>You can't export without a GB EORI, you must have one. Apply to HMRC using this link https://www.gov.uk/eori</p>
<input type="checkbox"/> Do you have the correct Tariff Code for the goods?	<p>This is the customs HS code, more info here on how to classify your goods for export/import purposes https://www.gov.uk/check-tariffs-1-january-2021</p>
<input type="checkbox"/> Do you need any export licence for the goods?	<p>Some goods require an export licence from HMRC. More info here: https://www.gov.uk/guidance/beginners-guide-to-export-controls</p>
<input type="checkbox"/> Do you need to supply a preference certificate?	<p>For example you may need this certificate if you send goods to Switzerland. More info here: https://www.gov.uk/guidance/importing-and-exporting-using-international-trade-preferences</p>
<input type="checkbox"/> Do you need to provide a proof of origin?	<p>You may need to provide a statement on origin to prove that the goods were made in GB. More info here: https://www.gov.uk/guidance/rules-of-origin</p>
<input type="checkbox"/> Are the goods subject to any other customs controls?	<p>Are the goods coming from a bonded warehouse or have been temporarily imported into GB for repair?</p>
<input type="checkbox"/> Do you have the commercial invoice & packing lists available?	<p>This is the minimum amount of information that is required to do the job, this info is the basis for the customs declaration.</p>
<input type="checkbox"/> Do you require a certificate of shipment?	<p>If the goods are shipped EXW, the exporter will need this as evidence of export, he may have to pay extra for this?</p>
<input type="checkbox"/> Does your invoice state the customs commodity code for your goods?	<p>You can get help here: https://www.gov.uk/guidance/ask-hmrc-for-advice-on-classifying-your-goods</p>
<input type="checkbox"/> Does your invoice state the Incoterms?	<p>The incoterms define the responsibilities and obligations for transport of the goods. More info here: https://iccwbo.org/publication/incoterms-2020-practical-free-wallchart/</p>

Guidelines for EU importers

<input type="checkbox"/> Do you have an EU EORI Number?	<p>You can't import without an EU EORI, you must have one. Apply to your EU country customs.</p>
<input type="checkbox"/> Do you have the correct Tariff Code for the goods, and do they appear on your invoices?	<p>This is the customs HS code, more info here on how to classify your goods for export/import purposes. https://ec.europa.eu/taxation_customs/business/calculation-customs-duties/what-is-common-customs-tariff/taric_en</p>
<input type="checkbox"/> Do you have your own Duty Deferment account?	<p>This is to pay any Duty/VAT directly to Customs, if not you can use CEVA account (subject to agreement)</p>
<input type="checkbox"/> Do you think you could benefit from a preferential origin ?	<p>You need to ask your seller if the goods qualify for this. If so, he will have to provide you all necessary documents such as a Statement on origin.</p>
<input type="checkbox"/> Do you need a certificate of origin?	<p>You may need this certificate to prove that the goods were made in a third country. More info here: https://ec.europa.eu/taxation_customs/business/calculation-customs-duties/rules-origin_en</p>
<input type="checkbox"/> Are the goods being imported temporarily?	<p>You might not have to pay any Duty/VAT if the goods are subject to re-exported from the EU</p>
<input type="checkbox"/> Do you have the commercial invoice & packing lists available?	<p>This is the minimum amount of information that is required to do the job, this info is the basis for the customs declaration.</p>
<input type="checkbox"/> Please complete the Direct Representative form on your own letterhead.	<p>You will need to authorise us to act on your behalf to make the customs declaration please use this template letter on your own letterhead and return it to us.</p>
<input type="checkbox"/> Do you need any Import licence for the goods?	<p>More info here: https://trade.ec.europa.eu/tradehelp/member-states-import-requirements#What_included</p>
<input type="checkbox"/> Does your invoice state the Incoterms 2020?	<p>The incoterms define the responsibilities and obligations for transport of the goods between sellers & importers. More info here: https://iccwbo.org/publication/incoterms-2020-practical-free-wallchart/</p>
